Thank you for the response. Can you please send me 2017 through whatever date the query is run? My request asked for the data “through the date in which this request is filled.”

Regarding the status of the case, Youngstown PD must track the status in a database, at the very least for UCR Reporting purposes. Do you have a UCR table that has the UCR code for the incident and its status (cleared/ exceptionally cleared/ not cleared)?

Hi Sarah,

To answer your questions:

- You only need to use the spreadsheet labeled “w/ robbery rape”. He reran the full request and I accidentally sent it to you

- Yes, all homicides, rapes, robberies and aggravated assaults. We have aggravated and felonious assault criminal codes in Ohio, but they both fall under aggravated assault according to the UCR definitions.
- When he ran the query, he mistakenly ran it through the end of 2016, thinking you wouldn't want a partial year. We checked your initial request and we can pull the data for a more current date. How much of 2017 do you want?
- Our case status will always show closed in our reporting system as long as the initial report was printed and sent to the proper division. We do not keep track of which specific cases are considered opened and closed. That falls on the investigator themselves I am told.

Let me know how you would like me to proceed.

Hi Julie,

Just a few quick questions before I dig in:

- Can you explain the difference between the two spreadsheets? Is the second one the same cases plus robbery and rape, or are there different cases on each sheet?
- Just to verify, altogether, this includes all UCR Part 1 violent crimes (rape, robbery, agg assault, homicide)? Or is it a different universe of cases?
- I don't see any cases from 2017. Not sure if that was an accident or if there is some reason they weren't included.
- I also don't see the case status (open, closed, etc.) Is it there? If not, would you just be able to send me an export of the Case Report Numbers and their status, which I can then join on my own? That was included in my initial request.

Thanks so much! I appreciate the effort you put into this and your updates throughout the process!
